

ATTENDANCE AT GENERAL ASSEMBLY

1. 'Minister' includes Full-time Chaplains and Auxiliary Ministers.
2. 'Elder' means a member of the Kirk Session. It does NOT mean the Presbytery Elder only.
3. Each year, 10 ministers and 10 Elders go to General Assembly, plus two Deacons.
4. The Deacons are chosen as per a separate rota.
5. The Ministers and Elders are from the same congregation if possible, failing which, Elders can be chosen from one of the other congregations within the same Group.
6. There are 6 groupings as per the list: **A – F**;
 - a. First year (2009, 2012, 2015), two each are chosen from A, B, C & D; one each from E & F.
 - b. Second year (2010, 2013, 2016), two each from E, F, A & B; one each from C & D.
 - c. Third year (2011, 2014, 2017), two each from C, D, E & F; one each from A & B.
7. Each group is to decide from its own members who are to go each year and notify the Clerk in phenomenally good time (***before December Presbytery meeting***).
8. The Minister or Interim Moderator of the first congregation in each Group is responsible for co-ordinating the names to be given to the Clerk.
9. In any year where a Linked Charge is chosen, Elders will alternate from each congregation.
10. The Clerk does not automatically go each year. S/he is chosen like everyone else.
11. Any disputes are to be resolved by the Clerk and Moderator, or failing agreement, the Presbytery.
